V31 Divorce from Deuteronomy 24:1-4

2 contemporary interpretations of the phrase the husband found "something indecent."

- 1. The conservative school believed it referred to some sort of sexual sin.
- 2. The liberal view held that it could refer to <u>anything</u> dissatisfying to the husband.

Giving the paper of divorcement doesn't solve the problem. It creates the problem of <u>adultery</u>.

Granting divorce this way showed no love for God.
