Scripture Reading Ps 145

**1. God's** \_\_\_\_\_ - Psalm 108:4

**2. God's Sovereignty and Omnipotence**

Omnipotence - Omni = \_\_\_\_\_. Potent = \_\_\_\_\_

Definition - God is able to do all his \_\_\_\_\_.

**1. God's Steadfast Love** - Psalm 108:4

**2. God's Sovereignty and Omnipotence**

Omnipotence - Omni = All. Potent = Powerful

Definition - God is able to do all his holy will.

God cannot do anything that would deny his own character.

Example - God cannot lie. Titus 1:2; Hebrews 6:18

Sovereignty – God’s exercise of power over his creation. Psalm 103:19, 115:3, 135: 5-6;  
Daniel 2:21, Proverbs 8:15-16

**3. God's Omniscience** - Psalm 139:1-4; Luke 12:7

Omniscience – Omni=All – Science = knowledge

God knows your situation.

**4. God's Righteousness** - Psalm 145:17

God will always do what is right.

**5. God's Faithfulness** - Psalm 33:4-5 - ...all his work is done in faithfulness

**6. Holiness** - Psalm 99:9

Holy means “set apart”.

God is not under the influence of anyone.
