Compare Ps 22 to Matt 27:39-46

Ps 22:6,7 - “I am a worm despised by the people. They mock me and wag their heads.”

Matt 27:39 – And those who passed by derided him, wagging their heads

Ps 22:8 — Matt. 27:43 - “He trusts in the LORD; let him deliver him;

Ps 22:16 vs Matt. 27:35; John 20:25 - they have pierced my hands and feet

Ps 22:18 - Matt 27:35 (Mark 15:24; Luke 23:34; John 19:24) - they divide my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots

Ps 22:22 vs Heb. 2:12 The writer of Hebrews directly quotes Psalms 22:22 and \_\_\_\_\_ these words to Jesus.

Matt 27:46 – “And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, “Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?” that is, “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?”

And someone says “He’s calling for Elijah!”

He is quoting Psalms 22.

Ps 22:22 – David can’t wait to \_\_\_\_\_ everyone about what God is going to do.

We are to tell others what God has done in giving his son Jesus for our salvation.
