

Prayer Part 2 - May 10 – Matt 6:9-14

Matthew 6:9 - “Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name.

Hallowed/Holy. It means \_\_\_\_\_. There needs to be a distinct recognition of God’s \_\_\_\_\_ to remind ourselves who we are speaking too.

V10 Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

Are our priorities \_\_\_\_\_ things or \_\_\_\_\_ things?  
The request here is for God to have his \_\_\_\_\_ and for the Kingdom of the Lord to be \_\_\_\_\_ fully.

V11 Give us this day our daily bread,

Jesus does not pray for \_\_\_\_\_ or for more but for \_\_\_\_\_. Daily. Ex: manna.

V12,14 and forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. See Col 2:14

If we truly desire that our sin be removed then we will be than willing to the \_\_\_\_\_ others.

V13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Pray that God will not allow us to go near something that will lead us \_\_\_\_\_.

3 Cautions

#1 Cheating the system

John 14:14 –If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it.

We can be guilty of stamping our prayer with “in Jesus name” to give it \_\_\_\_\_ even though we have given almost no thought as to whether or not our prayer is aligned with God’ will.

#2 Sin hinders prayer

1 John 3:22 - We cannot be living in \_\_\_\_\_ and have an expectation that God will hear our requests.

#3 Persistence

Luke 18:1 - Pray and do not \_\_\_\_\_.

Examples of Prayer from Paul

Ephesians 1:16-19; 3:14-19; 6:19-20; Colossians 1:9-11

Paul’s prayers are for “\_\_\_\_\_” things: “inner being”, “in your heart”, “having knowledge”

## Prayer Part 2 - May 10 – Matt 6:9-14

Matthew 6:9 - “Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name.

Hallowed/Holy. It means set apart. There needs to be a distinct recognition of God’s Holiness to remind ourselves who we are speaking too.

V10 Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

Are our priorities God things or our things?

The request here is for God to have his way and for the Kingdom of the Lord to be manifest fully.

V11 Give us this day our daily bread,

Jesus does not pray for abundance or for more but for enough. Daily. Ex: manna.

V12,14 and forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. See Col 2:14

If we truly desire that our sin be removed then we will be than willing to the forgive others.

V13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Pray that God will not allow us to go near something that will lead us astray.

### 3 Cautions

#### #1 Cheating the system

John 14:14 –If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it.

We can be guilty of stamping our prayer with “in Jesus name” to give it credibility even though we have given almost

#### #2 Sin hinders prayer

1 John 3:22 - We cannot be living in disobedience and have an expectation that God will hear our requests.

#### #3 Persistence

Luke 18:1 - Pray and do not give up.
